


## BEYOND// Jadagascar




## ARRIVE IN Atananario

#### 16th June to 17th June

## TRAVERSING Jakalava

#### 17th to 21st June

Our journey begins at Sakalava Bay, where we'll stay right on the water's edge at Mada Kite Camp. The bay is a paradise for kitesurfers, featuring a sandbar that creates the ideal flat-water spot, while a reef on the outskirts provides playful waves for those looking to ride.


From Sakalava, our adventure continues with an exhilarating 20km downwind into the stunning Emerald Sea. Alongside incredible kiting conditions, Sakalava Bay offers us a glimpse into local culture and unique wildlife like the crowned lemur and Sanford's brown lemur, adding even more magic to our time in Madagascar.

### KITESURFING IN merald fea

#### 21st to 25th June

For the next 4 days we will spend our time exploring the wonders of the Emerald Sea, searching for the optimal conditions, whilst enjoying the friendly hospitality of Mazava Loha Resort. The Emerald sea - a lagoon located at the entrance of the bay of Diego Suarez, where the water is the most incredible turquoise colour due to the sandy bottom and shallow waters. This 12 kilometre stretch of crystal clear water offers vast options for kiting and foiling alike - From barreling waves to butter flat water.






## MANJARANO Jush Camp

#### 25th to 27th June


Manjarano is built in the heart of a property of 180 hectares of primary and secondary forest sheltering unique fauna and flora in the world. The estate is also partially reforested with eucalyptus wood.

This private reserve allows you to see some of it in a supervised and animal-friendly way: whether it's reptiles, Nile crocodiles, chameleons or other species endemic to the big island. Not far from there, the reserve will allow you to meet several species of lemurs.



## LUXE Jea Jiens


The Luxe Option offers sea views in all the lodges, except in Antananarivo and Manjarano. All rooms have the option to split beds.




## Payment Policy

# FREQUENTLY ASKED Inestions

#### What are conditions like?

The winds are steady, blowing throughout the day at speeds between 15 and 40 knots. The waters are warm, making a short wetsuit or board shorts/bikini an ideal choice.

#### What kite sizes do I need?

Be sure to pack some smaller kites, as the winds can be quite strong. A kite larger than 12 meters won't be necessary. You'll find gear rentals available at the sites.

#### What level of riding do I need to be?

Intermediate to advanced kiters are encouraged to join. Participants should be capable of staying upwind, performing self-rescues, and remaining on the water for several hours. The Beyond team will be available at all times to provide assistance with rescues.

#### When can I see the Lemurs and Chameleons?

In Madagascar, Chameleons and Lemurs can be found almost everywhere, but Manjarano is a particularly vibrant hotspot for these stunning animals. Here, you'll have the wonderful opportunity to engage with these friendly creatures up close.
