- Check EU VISA requirements.
- Flights to go to Kittilä Airport (KTT)
- Arrival on the 20th of Feb and departure on the 3rd of March
- Transfers from airport to hotel not included, but we can arrange on request. Transfer prices: Flights from Helsinki to Kittilia €30 / direct flights to Kittilia €180.

DEPOSIT

- 1st payment of 50% to be paid on confirmation.

FREQUENTLY ASKED Inestions

What are conditions like?

Since 2013 we have had less than 5 absolute no wind days. So changes of solid conditions are very high. In case of no wind there is plenty of other things to do and see.

What kite sizes do I need?

On a normal week of Pallas you end up using any size you have with you. We recommend bringing an 8m,12m & 16m setup as you can choose a spot that has lighter or stronger wind.

What equipment do I need?

Pack multiple insulating layers for warmth as temperatures can drop as low as -30°C. Bring warm gloves and woolen hats but no need for a camera as a photographer / videographer will be present for the entire journey.

When and where can I see the Northern Lights?

Auroras are often visible in the night sky from late August until April when the sky is dark and clear. The Northern Lights can be seen anywhere in Lapaland. The Pallas hotel and surrounds one of the best places as the light pollution is very low.
